



Foods That Support Prostate Health

There is a long and delicious list of foods whose constituents can support your prostate to be healthful. Foods are only a part of the health care your prostate needs, so you'll need to consult with the doctor for a total regimen specifically designed for you. Be mindful to mix up the foods daily as some people can develop acquired sensitivities when one food is eaten on a daily or almost-daily basis. The extra benefits you'll get with these foods is that you just can't eat too much of them; they're very low in calories, high in fiber, loaded with nutrients and can be prepared in any number of ways. There are a number of recent studies that show drinking green tea (*not* decaffeinated) daily is also very helpful to increase your prostate health. Green tea has relatively small amounts of caffeine and most people can enjoy a cup into the evening without sleep disturbances.
